## A:

- Who is your supervisor?
- Do you have a fall protection plan?
- Where are your safety policies and procedures located?
- Wooden Ladders CANNOT be painted. EVER! It impedes inspection.
- Wooden Ladders must be inspected/recertified annually.
- There was a stop use order issued for the catwalks, ladders
- Fall protection program was required as a result of the investigation.
